About the Program:

What is going on with Health Care Reform in the last 30 to 60 days? This session will focus on the latest and greatest developments that have occurred around the time of the conference. Specifically, this session will apply to the owner/ employer who must provide benefits to employees or face penalties. Of course there will lots to talk about in avoiding penalties, workforce management strategies to lower exposure, compliance mandates, pay or play, subsidies, and practical implications. The session will discuss what others are doing, and what the future looks like under healthcare reform.
